# The Walworth Society is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This Policy explains when and why we collect personal information about people who visit our website, how we use it, the conditions under which we may disclose it to others and how we keep it secure. #### Who are we?

The Walworth Society aims to:

- Be a voice for people in Walworth.
- To preserve and protect its rich architectural heritage.
- To protect and help improve its green and open spaces.

The Walworth Society was established by, and is run by, volunteers from the local community. We are a strictly non-political group and aim to work positively and constructively with the Council and we greatly value the support and advice we receive from all of our councilors across the local area.

We were formed in December 2011 and we have a written constitution, elected officers and a committee which meets on a monthly basis.

# How do we collect information from you?

We obtain information about you when you use our website and contact us about being a member or if you register to receive one of our regular newsletters.

We also receive and process personal information regarding membership at events that we attend throughout the year.

### What type of information is collected from you?

The personal information we collect might include your name, email address and IP address.

#### How is your information used?

We may use your information to:

- Register you as a member of the society
- Enable us to send our email newsletters to you

We review our retention periods for personal information on a regular basis. We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary in terms of your being a member or wishing to receive newsletters from us

# What is our legal basis for processing your personal data?

Our lawful basis for processing your general personal data under article 6 of GDPR is as follows;

**Consent of the data subject** - We will directly ask for your consent to process data;

- When you signup for our regular newsletter on our website
- When you register as a member of the Walworth Society.

Processing necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests of the data controller or a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights or freedoms of the data subject;

• We will use your personal data to process and facilitate your membership of The Walworth Society.

# Who has access to your information?

The Walworth Society alone requires access to personal information such as name and email details in order to process your membership of the society and to allow us to send our newsletters to you. It is important to note:

- We will not sell or rent your information to third parties.
- We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes.

#### **Your choices**

We will not contact you for marketing purposes.
